January 2024 Contract Update

SDA is actively working on:

- **Data Ingestion** (*Contract Timeline 3-6 months*)
 - Analysts are currently converting database files into flat files and reconstructing the case management system.
 - SDA will then reshape the data to the case-defendant level and identify data gaps.
 - Analysts will continue conducting meetings with the SACDA IT department for clarification on data.
 - SDA will next determine that the data gathered is correct and prepare a data audit report that will outline key missing components. (**Anticipated delivery: March 2024**)

The next phase will be:

- **Data Backfilling** (*Contract Timeline 4-6 months*)
 - SDA will then work with the SACDA's office to identify additional internal databases that could contain the missing data as well as external locations where the missing data is maintained (e.g., court databases).
 - A plan for backfilling the missing content will be established.
 - SDA will complete the backfill/crawl and have a complete data set for analysis. (**Anticipated delivery: September 2024**)

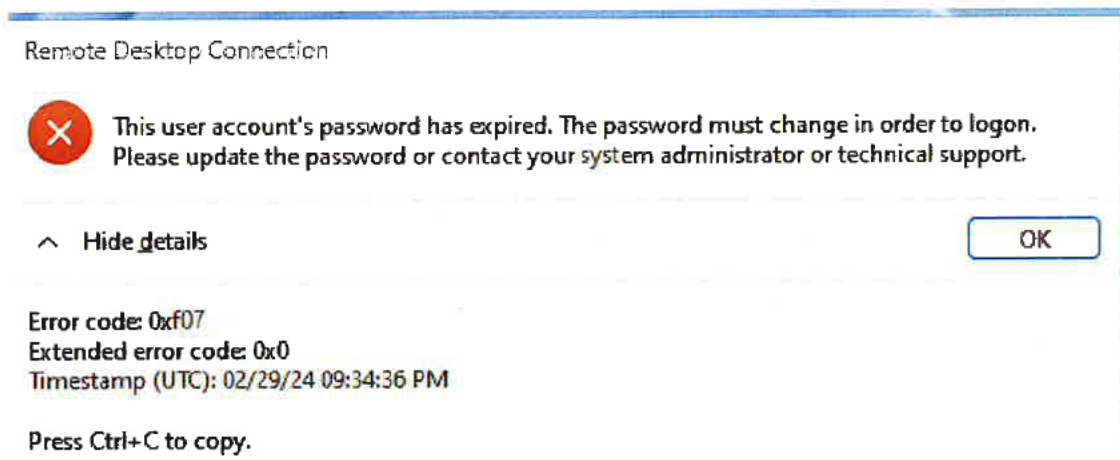
