

72010.12 CDC Form 112, Chronological Inmate History

The CDC Form 112, Chronological Inmate History, shall be filed as the second sheet in the case summary section of the C-File.

If additional pages are needed, the inmate's name, CDC number, and chronological page number shall be entered at the bottom of each page.

72010.12.1 Corrections to CDC Form 112

Use of white-out or correction tape is prohibited.

When an entry is no longer valid (e.g., detainer dropped, release date changed, or posting error), a single line shall be drawn through the entry. The notation "No Longer Valid," the date and staff initials shall be placed adjacent to the lined-through material.

72010.12.2 Postings to CDC Form 112

Entries on the CDC Form 112 shall only include inmate movement/location, data affecting legal status, release and discharge date, length of parole, requests from law enforcement agencies, courts, or interested parties requiring responses, and all BPT and NAEA actions.

All entries on the CDC Form 112 shall be clear, legible and in black ink except those which are specifically designated to be in red ink.

All entries shall be initialed.

Only the abbreviations listed below and the standard facility abbreviations shall be used to provide uniformity.



Foundation for PC 969b Packets

PC 969b – When trying to prove a defendant has a prior conviction and was sentenced to jail or prison time..."the records or copies of records of any state penitentiary, reformatory, county jail, city jail, or federal penitentiary in which such person has been imprisoned, when such records or copies thereof have been certified by the official custodian of such records, may be introduced as such evidence."

So PC 969b is a rule of evidence by itself. It allows for the 969b packet to be introduced into evidence. "The statute thus creates an exception to the hearsay rule." <u>People v. Taulton</u> (2005) 129 Cal.App.4th 1218.

A single certification is sufficient. Each page of the 969b package does not have to be individually certified. People v. Brucker (1983) 148 Cal. App. 3d 230.

Evidence Code 1452 & 1453 – Since the 969b packet contains an "official seal" and "domestic official signature", the seal and the custodian's signature on the 969b packet is presumed genuine. The prosecution doesn't have to call a witness to the stand to testify about the authenticity of the seal and signature. That means the seal and signature portions of the 969b packet are "self-authenticating".

Evidence Code 1530 & 1531 – A copy of an original writing from a public entity (such as the 969b packet which is a copy of records from CDCR or FSO) is presumed to be an actual copy of the original document if the packet is certified.

Evidence Code 1530 & 1531 along with Evidence Code 1452 & 1453 mean the entire 969b packet is "self-authenticating".

Evidence Code 1280 – Records by public employees are not made inadmissible by the hearsay rule. EC 1280 should be considered as an alternative exception to the hearsay rule, after the much simpler PC 969b and <u>People v. Taulton</u> exception.

People v. Fielder (2004) 114 Cal.App.4th 1221. – This case has a good general discussion about prison prior "washout".

Falled to refrain from using and possessing marijuana: On 1/1/14, your officer contacted the defendant on College/Andrews Street in the City of Fresno. He was detained and during a search of his person, your officer found a baggie of marijuana in his left pants pocket. When asked when he last used any alcohol or narcotics, the defendant admitted to using marijuana 10 minutes prior to our contact. The defendant was then arrested, read his Miranda Rights, and transported to the Fresno County Jali without incident. On 1/9/14, a remand-to custody was submitted to the Court and the matter was placed on calendar for a VOP Arraignment Hearing for 1/10/14.

Prior VOP(s): On 8/1/11, the defendant admitted to his 1st VOP for being out of contact and positive drug test. Probation was revoked and reinstated, he was sentenced to 304 days in custody with credit for time served, and released on resolutions.

On 6/17/13, the defendant admitted to his 2nd VOP in light of the plea in Conditional case M13920469. Probation was revoked and reinstated, probation was extended for an additional two years until 8/24/15, he was sentenced to 317 days in custody with credit for time served, and released on probation.

Negative drug test(s): 7/12/13, 7/26/13, 8/9/13, 8/23/13, 9/6/13, 9/20/13, 10/4/13, 10/18/13, 11/1/13, and 11/15/13.

Conclusion: The defendant is before the Court relevant to his 3rd VOP for the above violations. It appears when he has family issues he absconds from supervision and relapses, either by using alcohol or narcotics. A couple of violations into his probation, your officer has some serious reservations about reinstatement based upon his overall non-compliance; however, in considering his youthful age and the fact that he has not exhausted all local resources, your officer believes he can still benefit from further probation services. At this time, your officer will recommend the defendant waive his time credits for local purposes, serve time in local custody, and be enrolled in the Adult Day Reporting Center to address his needs. The defendant should be admonished if he falls to comply again, the next recommendation could be local prison.



The above-entitled matter came on before the Court on February 26, 2002, pursuant to Defendant's written Petition to Enter Plea of Guilty in Felony or Gross Misdemeanor Case, Pursuant to Rule 15. The Commissioner may extend the time in prison up to the entire sentence of 159 months if the Defendant commits any disciplinary offense or supervised release violations.


