



Before Trial

<ul> <li>Consider prospective defenses;</li> <li>Discovery;</li> <li>Follow-up</li> </ul>


## Before Trial When you learn who your expert is, obtain their CV & immediately discover it. ■ DUI: Crime Lab analyst; ■ H&S § 11550 (UI): DRE for UI opinion, Crime Lab analyst for tox., perhaps recent use theory; ■ H&S § 11350, 11377 (Poss.): Crime Lab analyst for drugs, perhaps DRE for usable amount. Read CV for basis of experience (e.g., lab v. street), follow-up & hero questions Percipient Witnesses Any witness' observations (EC § 702, · Civilians; Victims; Officers; Medical personnel & EMTs Prepare for speculation objections ■ (But see, e.g., *People v. Ruiz* (1968) 265 Cal.App.2d 766, 773 ["a non-expert witness may give his opinion as to the intoxication or sobriety of a defendant."].) Percipient Witnesses Officer or medical personnel ■ Blood Tests ■ Breath Tests ■ DIR Remember to prepare examination of percipient witnesses to include all facts for expert's opinion(s)



































































