2017 LAW CHANGES CONT.

- PC 647(b) (Amended) Multiple changes to the prostitution statute include adding an intent to receive pay compensation (subdivisions (b)(1-3); provision that a child under 18 does not commit prostitution (subdivision (b)(5), chimination of the mandatory minimum jail terms for subsequent convictions (subdivision (k); and imposing minimum maximum penalties where the violator knew or should have known the person solicited was a minor (subdivision (m)).
- Evid. Code 1107.5 (Added) Expert testimony may be admitted on the issue of the effects of human trafficking on victims.
