SUBJECT: ADVANCED VIP TRAINING: OVERCOMING GENDER BIAS IN
DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEX CASES - OCTOBER 8, 2019

The Training Division is pleased to announce that we have rescheduled the one-day Advanced Victim Impact Program (VIP) Training that was cancelled in August. It will be offered Tuesday October 8, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (registration begins at 8:00 a.m.). It will be held at:

This advanced training will cover how to overcome gender bias in domestic violence and sex crimes cases. Speakers include Mieko Failey, Esq., Director of LGBTQ Legal Services at the LGBTQ Center Long Beach and Janis Johnson, VIP DIC Long Beach Branch. They will cover biases that can occur throughout the investigation and prosecution, including identifying and combating community and juror biases. The program will qualify for six hours of elimination of bias MCLE credit.

Special Directive (SD) 08-02 (Policy and Procedural Changes Resulting from the Harris Report) requires each deputy district attorney assigned to a VIP team to complete one Advanced VIP Training annually. DDAs must have completed the required VIP 3-Day Comprehensive Course to attend the advanced-level VIP training course.

To register, obtain approval from your Head Deputy and VIP DIC and notify Susan Powers in the Training Division by email at spowers@da.lacounty.gov before October 4, 2019. DDAs requesting parking in Lot 12 next to the Hall of Justice must include in the enrollment email the year, make, model, color and license plate of the car to be parked. Requests for parking must be made more than 48 hours before the training. The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department processes parking requests. Depending on parking availability, approval for parking cannot be guaranteed.
