SUBJECT: REORGANIZATION OF TARGET CRIMES DIVISION

DATE: OCTOBER 18, 2019

During my tenure as District Attorney, I have made changes in our office organizational structure in order to improve operational efficiency, utilize our resources effectively and address emerging justice system issues impacting our office mission. With these goals in mind, I am announcing that the Crimes Against Peace Officers Section will separate from the Target Crimes Division and become the Crimes Against Peace Officers Division (CAPOS).

The Target Crimes Division will continue to be comprised of the Arson and Explosives Section, the Child Abduction Section and the Stalking and Threat Assessment Team (S.T.A.T). The Animal Cruelty Coordinator will also now report to the Head Deputy and Assistant Head Deputy of the Target Crimes Division. There will no longer be a Deputy-in-Charge of the Child Abduction Section. This Section will now report to the Head Deputy and Assistant Head Deputy of the Target Crimes Division.

These changes will be effective on November 1, 2019.
