Sheriff and CJAA Members,

Attached is our office's memorandum for law enforcement with guidance on what offenses and what enhancements qualify for zero bail.

**Noteworthy:**

If someone is arrested for a violation of Felony probation, Parole, or PRCS they will have bail set at the 'regular' SLO Bail Schedule amount - based on the charge that they were convicted of and for which they are being supervised. ALSO, if a new case is charged then that new offense must also be reviewed to determine if bail in that case is zero or excepted from zero bail.

**Bottom line:** please require every deputy / officer to read and be very familiar with this memorandum. The Emergency Order is very confusing. My Office team will always be available to answer questions by email or by phone. Please encourage your deputies / officers to call a DDA or a Supervising Attorney for answers 24x7. It is up to all of us to ensure that we keep the dangerous criminals IN jail and off the streets.

Finally, please do not hesitate to give out my personal cell phone [REDACTED]. I am firmly committed to getting an answer to law enforcement at any time 24x7x365 should they have a question. If they cannot reach one of my staff after :15 minutes of trying, please have them call me.

A heart felt thank you to you and your professional Deputies, Officers, Wardens for your exceptional service during this prolonged emergency. I am very proud of our team and the good work that everyone is doing. We are in this together.
