The DUI Training and Prosecution Section (DTAPS) is pleased to announce a two-day Vehicular Homicide College to be held **Wednesday, October 21, 2020 through Thursday, October 22, 2020**. The College is open to all prosecutors. The training will be from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day and attendance will be available only via Microsoft Teams. The training also qualifies for participatory MCLE credit if web-cams remain on for the duration of the training for verification purposes, pursuant to California State Bar requirements.

The topics will include:

- Legal Aspects in Vehicular Homicide Cases
- Collision Reconstruction
- Biomechanics (How Injuries Can Determine Vehicle Occupant Placement and Recreate Movement)
- Street Racing Investigations
- Prosecuting *Watson* Murders
- DUI-Drug Related Vehicular Homicides
