	For background - this Defendant and his accomplice committed a planned and calculated robbery of the bowling alley at the Concord Mall. Dillahunty was a security guard there and the inside man. He allowed Timmons and an unknown third part to enter and rob the business. Both Defendants had recently been paroled from their second strike offense where they each did 15 years.
	In court this week an offer of 12 yrs was made to each defendant to resolve this case. Mr. Ashe wanted probation and prison suspended. I refused and now we have this discovery request being served upon us.
