On July 19, 2021, the Antioch Police Department received your Public Records Act (PRA) request for records pertaining to training records and


The Public Records Act, California Government Code section 6250 et seq. applies to existing and identifiable public records in the possession of the City. The cost of copies of such records is generally 20 cents per page; although, there are additional costs for copies of plans and other oversized documents.

We appreciate your patience while we work on responding to your request. In accordance with GC 6253(c)(1) we are extending our response period for up to 14 additional calendar days to search for and collect records from a separate offices or departments holding the information requested. You will be notified with a response to your request on or before, August 12, 2021, and will be notified if fees will be due to our department, at that time.
