Dear Ms. Leonida:

The County of Madera (the "County") is in receipt of your September 7, 2021, Public Records Act ("PRA") request, which the County received on or about September 10, 2021.

Pursuant to Government Code section 6253, subdivision (c), we are extending the 10-day response period for an additional 14 days up to and including, October 4, 2021. This extension of response time is necessary, due to the voluminous nature of the records requested, to search, collect, appropriately examine records, and to determine if any non-privileged records exist responsive to your request. Therefore, the County will notify you in writing by **October 4, 2021**, whether any non-privileged records exist.

As always, the County will respond appropriately and will provide disclosable records in accordance with its obligations under the PRA. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding this matter.
