Public Records Act Request – Racial Justice Act (2)

Dear Ms. Leonida:

The County of Madera (the "County") hereby supplements its response dated October 4, 2021 to your Public Records Act ("PRA") request which seeks records related to the implementation of the Racial Justice Act and certain charge-level data for cases considered for prosecution from 2015 to present.

Please find attached all located documents that are responsive to your request. Despite its diligent investigation, the County anticipates additional documents will be available by October 18, 2021. The County will supplement this response as soon as those records are received.

With regard to this production, the County will not produce any records that are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Penal Code section 13300 or are otherwise exempt by federal or state law. (Pen. Code, § 13300, subd. (b); Gov. Code, § 6254, subd. (k).) Additionally, the release of any records which contain sensitive and private information would constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy, and therefore the public interest served by not disclosing the records clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure. (Gov. Code, § 6255.) Accordingly, such information is redacted from the records produced.

County Counsel Regina A. Garza is the responsible party for asserting the exemptions.
