Re: California Public Records Act Request

Dear Mr. DeClark:

I am in receipt of your letter dated November 30, 2021 and would like to clarify several points. Regarding the request from the ACLU dated July 23, 2021 for policies and training materials, we stand by the exceptions outlined in our response dated September 27, 2021. Our conclusions regarding our obligations under the California Public Records Act aside, we have decided to share the documents supplied on September 27, 2021. The documents supplied represent all of the materials in our possession that we were able to identify that fit the parameters outlined in the ACLU request.

Regarding the ACLU request for defendant information, our office stands by the exceptions noted in our letter dated September 29, 2021. However, we are currently exploring the possibility of retrieving fundamentally the same information contained in the ACLU request. Our office is working with a group to retrieve information from our data system, and should that prove viable, we expect to complete the project in the spring. Our office anticipates making the results of that study available to you. Additionally, should this project prove to be something we cannot complete, we will promptly advise you of this fact.
