Re: California Public Records Act Request

To the Office of the District Attorney for Tehama County:

I am writing today regarding your refusal to produce documents pursuant to our CPRA requests dated July 23 and September 7, 2021.

You have not responded at all to our July 23, 2021 request. You sent a letter dated August 31, 2021 addressing only the renewal of our 2019 request. You produced no documents and did not respond to any element of the new request. We informed you of this in a letter dated November 15, 2021. We also sent a letter dated January 25, 2022 asking, again, for a response.

You responded to our September 7, 2021 request, which sought 15 categories and 54 subcategories of data, with a short paragraph essentially telling us you are not required to respond to our request. We responded in a letter dated January 25, 2022 informing you that your response was not legally sufficient and requesting additional information. You did not respond. To date, you have produced no data in response to our request.

You have continued to ignore our communications and we are now writing to inform you that we will be initiating litigation to obtain the requested documents and will be seeking attorney's fees for the cost of that litigation. If you wish to avoid this, you must contact our office immediately.
