Dear Mr. Wilner:

This letter is in further response to your Public Records Act request received by the San Joaquin County District Attorney's office on February 16, 2022. This letter constitutes a written response pursuant to Government Code Section 6255(b), and is based upon the authorities interpreting the California Public Records Act ("CPRA) and Article I, Section 3 of the California Constitution.

Please note that the exemptions and objections stated in my letter of March 11, 2022 are incorporated herein.

Thank you for clarifying your requests in our call of March 16, 2022. We have carefully reviewed your request and the District Attorney's capability to provide the information according to the categories you outlined. As we noted in our telephone call, the database used by the District Attorney is an older system and not capable of extracting much of the information you seek.

We have prepared the attached chart listing your requests and identifying the applicable category.. For category 3, we provide the specific exemptions below.

For requests numbers 1(a), 1(b), 1(c), 1(d), and 2(e): the records call for documents exempt pursuant to Government Code sections 6254(f), (k), and 6255(a); Penal Code sections 11140(b), 11141, 11142, 13300-13305; California Constitution, Article I, Section I; Westbrook v. County of Los Angeles (1994) 27 Cal. App. 4th 157.

The County does not waive any privileges, protections or objections which might be available in any future litigation, and without waiving any additional privileges, protections or exemptions available under the CPRA.
