




Evidence Code Section 1270

 "Business" includes every kind of business, Govt activity, profession, occupation, calling or operation of institutions...


- Evidence Code Section 1271
- Evidence of a writing made as a record of an act is not made inadmissible by the hearsay rule when offered to prove the act, condition or event if: The writing was made
 - a) in the regular course of business
 - b) at or near the time of act, condition or event
 - The custodian or other qualified witness testifies to its identity and mode of preparation
 - The source of info, method and time of preparation indicate trustworthiness





- Peo v. Lopez (2012) 55 Cal.4th 569, 581-582
 - Court found that results were "Non-Testimonial" (I will get to that) under Crawford.
 - Because it is "data generated by a gas chromatography machine"
 - You can't cross a machine therefore it did not implicated 6th amendment Right to Confrontation
 - Once the Judge is on board you call your Toxicologist who lays the foundation for the Business Record





CHARACTER EVIDENCE: METHOD OF PROOF



EVIDENCE CODE SECTION 1101

- Generally speaking, evidence of a person's character is INADMISSIBLE when offered to prove conduct on a specific occasion
- HOWEVER, evidence of specific uncharged acts (bad acts)
 is admissible when relevant to prove some fact other than
 "propensity" to commit the criminal act






EXPERT WITNESSES

If a witness is testifying as an expert, his testimony in the form of an opinion is limited to such an opinion as is:

- (a) Related to a subject that is sufficiently beyond common experience that the opinion of an expert would assist the trier of fact; and
- **(b)** Based on matter (including his special knowledge, skill, experience, training, and education) perceived by or personally known to the witness...



PEOPLE V. SANCHEZ (2016) 63 CAL.4TH 665

- An expert is precluded from relating <u>case-specific facts</u> about which the expert has no independent knowledge.
- Must first establish case specific facts from witness testimony or through the expert if he/she has personal knowledge of case specific facts
- An expert may then testify about more generalized information to help jurors understand the significance of those case-specific facts.
- An expert is also allowed to give an opinion about what those facts may mean.



RULE OF COMPLETENESS EC 356

 Evidence Code section 356 provides, "Where part of an act, declaration, conversation, or writing is given in evidence by one party, the whole on the same subject may be inquired into by an adverse party...

Rule is available to both prosecution and defense



THE RULE

- Only applicable in co-defenant trials
- A defendant's 6th Amendment right to confront and crossexamine witnesses is violated when the <u>testimonial</u> <u>statement</u> of a codefendant that facially and/or powerfully implicates the defendant is admitted in their joint trial regardless of whether the jury is instructed it can only use and consider the codefendant's statement against the codefendant
